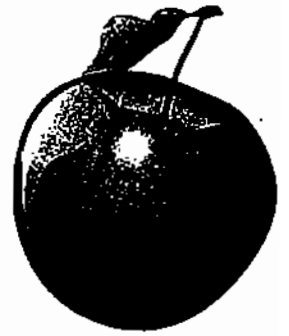

Hardy Fruit Tree Selections

Type	Zone	Description
<u>APRICOT</u>		
<i>Moongold</i>	4	Light orange fruit 1.75" in size. Flavor is sweet, but with a slight acidity. Flowers late April and ripens late July. 10-15ft tall. Moongold is a good pollinator.
<i>Sungold</i>	4	Good quality eating fruit has clear golden color. Fruit is 1.25" in size and is mild and sweet. Flowers late April and ripens early August. Upright growth habit to 10-15ft tall. Sungold is a good pollinator.
<u>APPLE</u>		
<i>Goodland</i>	3	One of the very best of the hardy apples. Flesh is firm and good for eating, cooking and storing. Flowers mid season and ripens late September. Full size 20ft x 20ft.
<i>Halared</i>	3	A firm, dark pink-red apple with a juicy, sweet-tart flavor. Fireblight resistant. Heavy producer and a good keeper. Flowers late season and ripens late September. Semi-Dwarf 12-15ft tall and wide.
<i>Honeycrisp</i>	4	An exciting, new apple that has become outstanding because of it's explosive crispness, flavor and storage life. Flowers mid season and ripens late September. Semi-Dwarf 12-15ft tall and wide.
<i>McIntosh</i>	4	An all time favorite after nearly 200 years. Crisp flesh, dark red peel. Especially good after the first autumn frosts. Flowers mid season and ripens late September. Semi-Dwarf 12-15ft tall and wide.
<i>Red Wealthy</i>	3	An improved strain of Wealthy with white firm flesh. Flowers early-mid season and ripens mid September. Semi-Dwarf 12-15ft Tall and wide.
<i>Sweet Sixteen</i>	4	An excellent desert apple with sweet, unusual flavor. Medium red striped fruit with crisp, juicy texture. Fire-blight resistant. Flowers mid season and ripens mid-late September. Semi-Dwarf 12-15ft tall and wide.

Pollination of Apple Trees

Use two varieties from the same or similar flowering times.

Early: Hazen, Norland, Red Wealthy, State Fair, Whitney, Yellow Transparent

Mid: Goodland, Honeycrisp, Honeygold, McIntosh, Red Barron, Sweet Sixteen

Late: Delicious, Halared, Haralson, Red Regent

CHERRY

Evan's Bali 3 Selected for good bud hardiness. Large red 1" fruit is one of the sweetest sour cherries which is good for fresh eating or baking. Flowers early May and ripens August. Grows to a height of 15-20ft. Self Pollinating.

Montmorency 4 A vigorous grower producing large, tart red fruit. Fruit is firm and juicy and is good for pies or preserves. Flowers early May and ripens late June. Grows to 12-18ft tall and wide. Self Pollinating.

PEARS

Luscious 4 Juicy, sweet bright yellow fruit and is excellent eating and desserts. Red Fall color. Flowers early May and ripens late September. Semi-Dwarf to a height of 15-20ft tall. Fireblight resistant. Pollen-sterile cannot be used to pollinate a second pear tree. Parker is a good pollinator.

Parker 4 A large, fine grained, tender fruit, yellow to bronze in color. Flowers early May and ripens in August. Vigorous Semi-Dwarf upright grower to 10-15ft tall. Needs pollinator and is a good pollinator for Luscious.

PLUMS

American 3 White flowers bear golden purple fruit that is used for jams and jellies. Drought tolerant tree that grows in tree form or thickets. Flowers in March/April and ripens late June/July. Reaches 10-15ft tall. Self pollinating.

Mount Royal 4 Blue European plum which is good eaten off the tree, or for desserts, jams and preserves. Tender, juicy flesh. Flowers early May and ripens late August. Reaches 8-12ft height. Self Pollinating.

Toka 3 Red, medium sized, richly flavored variety with beautiful apricot color. Flowers late April and ripens mid August. Reaches 10-15ft tall. Requires pollinator.
